Subject: Penalty for Unsportsmanlike Conduct

Dear Mr. Daley,

Following the review of your conduct during Round 1 of the Canadian Superbike Championship, at **Shannonville Motorsports Park**, it has been determined that you committed two *infractions* that violate the rules and regulations of the Canadian Superbike Championship (CSBK). The specific infractions are as follows:

- 1. Unsportsmanlike Conduct Shouting obscenities at another rider following the Pro Superbike race on Saturday.
- 2. Racing Incident Side by side contact while attempting to pass bike #91 exiting turn 10 during Supersport race.

These actions are considered unsportsmanlike. Disrespectful behavior from any racers or teams toward CSBK staff, series sponsors, and other teams will not be tolerated. Involving the racing incident, cleaner passing should be attempted. As a result, the following penalty has been issued:

Penalty: Probation for the Season

During this probation period, any further infractions of CSBK rules and regulations may result in more severe penalties.

We expect all riders to adhere to the highest standards of conduct and safety. Your cooperation in maintaining these standards is essential for the integrity and safety of the sport.
